




- Encouraging FRA (Forestry Reclamation Approach)

Saving Soil, Seed, and Woody Material For Reclamation



Geomorphic Reclamation, or "Landforming."

Constructing artificial landforms that are stable in the <u>long-term</u> and maintenance free, and look like they belong.



Tailings-disposal fill configurations: (a) "outward"-facing slope of valley fill once constructed and graded and (b) adjacent natural slope, whose topographical form would have made an ideal natural analog for the "outward" slope. 


